Minutes

1. Welcome

JM welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. Previous Minutes

JM gave the financial update. At present, the Parent Council have around £2,200 in the bank account (to be confirmed). Christmas Extravaganza raised £1800. Tesco fundraiser raised £1,720 which was given to the school.
